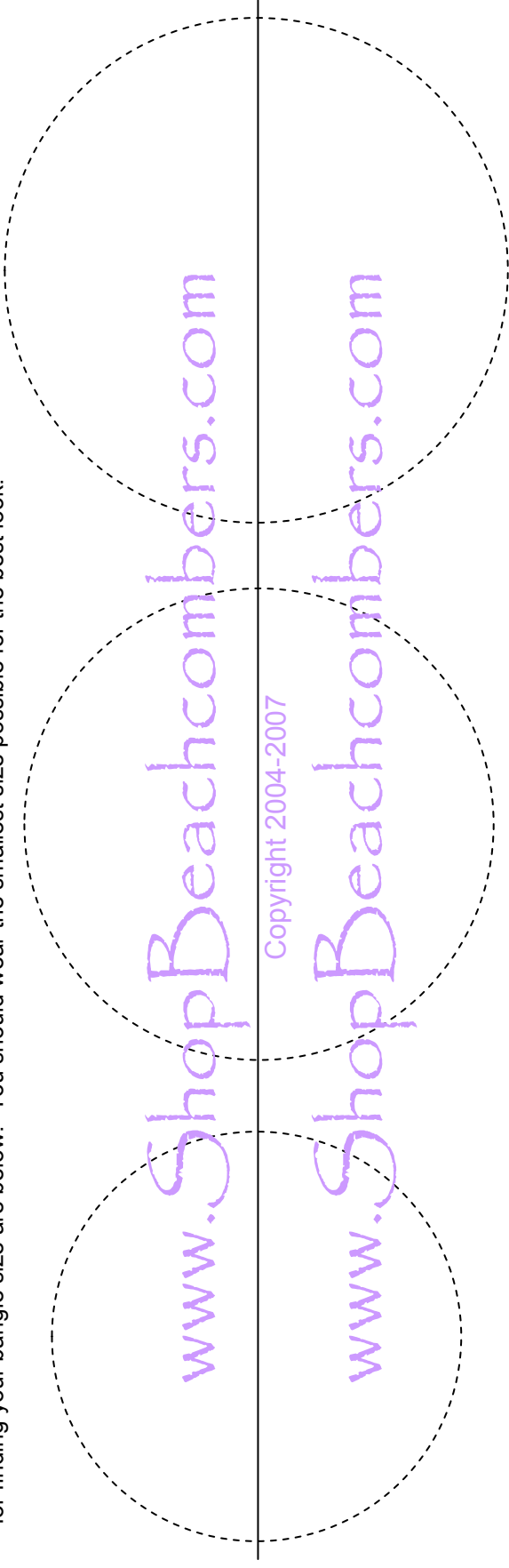


## What Size Glass Bangles Do I Wear?

Glass bangles can be tricky to put on, especially if you've never worn them before. The first step is getting the correct size. Directions for finding your bangle size are below. You should wear the smallest size possible for the best look.



**Small 2.6**

**Med/Large 2.10**

**Extra-Large 2.12**

### For correct scale when printing:

When your print box "pops up": under the heading "Print Handling" turn OFF auto rotate & center. Under "Page Scaling" choose NONE.

1. Print this page (using above instructions).
2. Fold page carefully on the line, printed side out (this will make it easier to cut out the circles).
3. With page folded, cut out marked circles, being careful to cut out the entire circle.
4. Unfold the paper. Slowly and carefully work your hand through a circle.  
**It should be a very tight fit, nearly tearing the paper.** If you can easily slip your hand through the circle, that size is too big. Glass bangles are hard and can take much more pressure than paper can.
5. The **smallest** circle you are able to work your hand through, is your Beachcombers! bangle size.
